A summer teacher institute will be offered for any teacher who is interested in experiencing the arts of the 18th and 19th centuries. Teachers will focus on the Trades unit lessons that are available for their students, be introduced to the history and background material, and work with the artisans to experience the various historic processes including traditional blacksmithing, tinsmithing, scrimshaw, and more. The session will build on the introductory Teacher Institutes from the past several years, and may be taken by teachers who want to delve deeper into this particular unit, but previous participation is not required. The Institute will meet daily from Sunday, July 24 through Thursday, July 28, 2011, at Pricketts Fort in Fairmont. Cost: PFMF Members \$126, Non-members \$140. Fee includes all activities including project materials and meals. Optional three graduate credits hours can be earned through Fairmont State for a fee of \$99 (plus app fee) if desired.
